BULKY ITEM & HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL OPTIONS

BULKY ITEMS

Effective April 17, 2006, all City of Santa Clarita households, who have trash service, are entitled to four bulky item pickups per year with a maximum of three items per pickup at no charge. Please provide Waste Management/Blue Barrel Disposal with at least 48 hours notice in order to have the items picked up on your regular collection day. City residents may also drop-off unlimited bulky items at Waste Management's facility located at 25772 Springbrook Road, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at no charge.

"Bulky Items" means solid waste that cannot and/or would not typically be accommodated within a trash, recycling or greenwaste cart: furniture (including chairs, sofas, mattresses, and rugs); appliances (including refrigerators – with or without Freon and with the doors removed, ranges, washers, dryers, water heaters, water softeners – with salt removed if applicable, dishwashers, plumbing, small household appliances, and other similar items commonly know as "white goods"; electronic equipment (including stereos, televisions, computers, monitors, cellular phones, VCRs, microwaves, and other similar items commonly known as "brown goods" and "e-waste"); residential wastes (including wood waste, tree branches, scrap wood, limited debris from building remodeling, rocks, sod and earth, in the aggregate not exceeding one cubic yard per collection); clothing; and tires. Bulky items do not include car bodies, construction and demolition debris or items requiring more than two persons to remove.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Help preserve the quality of life in Santa Clarita by properly disposing of unwanted Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). The City of Santa Clarita offers FREE door-to-door collection of limited amounts of anti-freeze, batteries, motor oil and filters, and oil and latex paint for City residents. The pickups are limited to one per household every 12 months and are available on a first come, first served basis. To schedule a FREE collection of the items listed above, please contact Curbside, Inc. at (800) HHW-PKUP (800-449-7587). For disposal of HHW items not listed above, please contact the City of Santa Clarita's Environmental Services Division at (661) 286-4098.

L.A. County residents can dispose of HHW for FREE at a HHW Roundup or permanent collection center. A permanent collection center is located at 11025 Randall Street, Sun Valley, 91352 and is open Saturday, Sunday and Monday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00.p.m. Roundups are scheduled for most weekends and are located throughout L.A.
